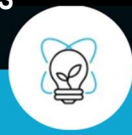

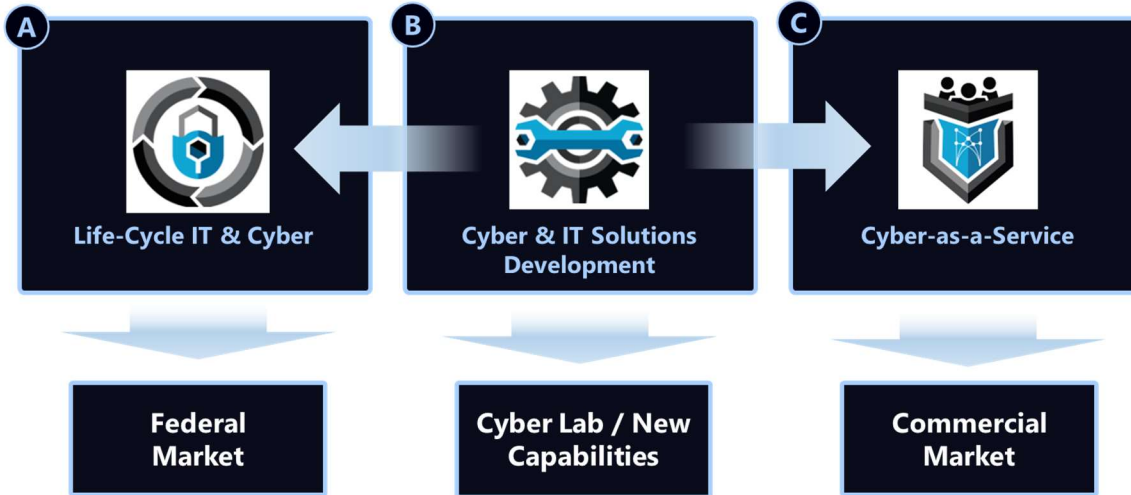

LOGNET – Mission Multiplier supports the Air Mobility Command (AMC) to enable the readiness and security of the Single Maintenance Information System (SMIS) and Field Maintenance Command and Control (FMxC2) systems for the AMC Program Management Office (PMO) and users worldwide. As part of this support, Mission Multiplier leads FMxC2 Management, Support and Training for approximately 820 FMxC2 users and leadership. Our engagement includes IT and cyber testing and maintenance support for the IT infrastructure supporting wing-level Logistics and the PMO. More specifically, we provide maintenance, enhancement, and end-user support for weapons systems (flight line), electronic tools (eTools), mobile computing devices, cloud computing infrastructure, and supporting systems. Our support further includes technical assistance to Air Force users providing training, product development, cybersecurity, and database, web page and application, and programming integration.

Purple Team Support – Mission Multiplier supports the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) with strengthening its cybersecurity defenses by establishing a purple team program. Our engagement creates a collaborative environment where Red (offensive) and Blue (defensive) Teams work together, sharing insights and strategies to improve the organization’s ability to detect, respond to, and thwart cyber threats. To achieve this end, we conduct numerous cyber threat hunt exercises and Red Team assessments, while also developing tailored training curricula for the USPTO Blue Team. We also develop and conduct cyber modeling and simulation – to simulate the potential impact of a cyber threat or vulnerability on a specific system. We then take the results of our testing to inform and create focused cyber training to ensure the appropriate remediations are implemented. Our results also inform USPTO application developers and the continuous integration and continuous development (CI/CD) pipeline (through the Agile sprint cycle) so that each application release is cyber-secure.
